#### **Artist Fees**

The fees are complex and differ depending on the qualifications and experiences of the artist being contracted, and the size of the organisation contracting the artists.

The following table is an indicative guide to industry rates for 2017/18

Curator	\$55 - \$90	\$65 - \$108	
Musicians	\$25 - \$49	\$32 - \$90	
Dancers and performers (rehearsal)	\$23 - \$28	\$29 - \$36	
Dancers and performers (performance)			\$185 -\$220 (performance fee)

Photographer \$500 - \$1000 (day rate)
Videographer \$1355 (day rate)

#### Volunteers

Accommodation: \$120 - \$220+ per night, depending on location (ATO)

\$122 per night, or \$804-\$1223 per week reimbursed (LPA)

Use of own vehicle: from 66c per km (ATO) - 78c per km (LPA)

Meals per day: \$55.53 (LPA) - \$109.35 (ATO) Incidentals per day: \$15.13 (LPA) - \$19.35 (ATO)
