Germans most significant and important artist and graphic designer and of the Nothern Renaissance. Born in Nuernberg, his ealry training in art included glass painting, altar pieces, book illustrations, engravings and wood cuts. he married Barbara Holper and they had eighteen children together.

He was fascinated with the principles of mathematics, perspective and ideal proportions.

He reached International fame and influencial reputation at the early age of twenty. Albrecht produced thousands of drawings and numerous portraits of well know personalities of his time.
