Pablo's full name was Pablo Diego José Francisco de Paula Juan Nepomuceno María de los Remedios Cipriano de la Santísima Trinidad Ruiz Picasso.

His skills included: painting, sculpting, printmaking, stage design, ceramic and poetry. He was co-founder of the Cubist Movement.

Picasso achieved immense success and fortune and remains a world-renowned artist and figure of 20th century art.

He underwent different periods of painting including the "Blue Period", "Rose Period", "African Period" and "Crystal" Period.
