## Dutch Artist

Rembrandt Harmenszoon van Rijn is considered to be one of the world's greatest painters in European history.

He created a range of different subject matter including self-portraits, landscapes, biblical and mythological themes. He was also known for his innovative etchings and use of shadow and light.

Rembrandt achieved an early artistic successful career but was later in his life plagued by personal tragedy and financial hardship.
