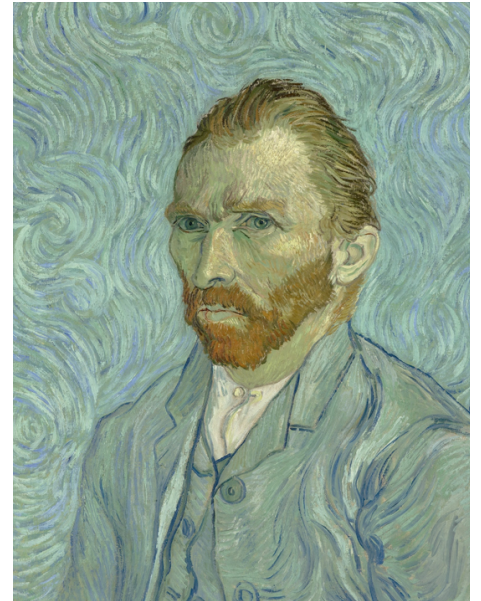


VINCENT VAN GOGH

Vincent Willem Van Gogh is one of the world's most famous and influential artists in history. In his short life he created almost 2,100 artworks of which are 860 oil paintings.

Vincent suffered from mental health problems with psychotic episodes and delusions.

He was unsuccessful during his lifetime and became only famous after his suicide.

Albert Aurier characterised his work as "fire, intensity, sunshine."

The Van Gogh Museum opened in Amsterdam in 1973.
