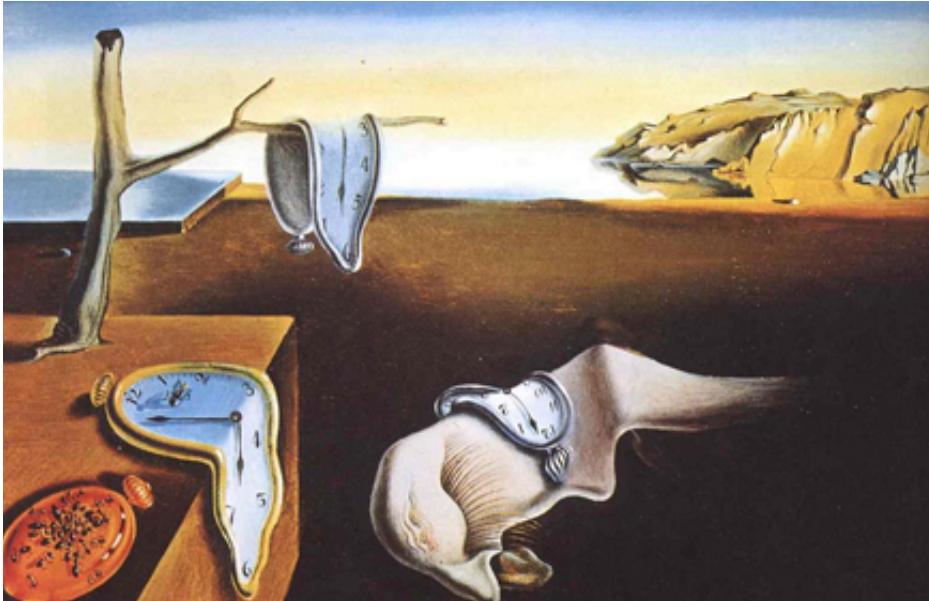


SALVADORE DALI

Salvador Domingo Felipe Jacinto Dalí i Domènech, Marqués de Dalí de Púbol is one of the world's best known surreal painters.

He is famous for his bizarre and imaginative images of melting watches and long-legged animals. His eccentric nature often drew more attention than his work. Some find his work irritating and appalling whereas to others it is brilliant.

Dali has produced over 1,500 paintings in his lifetime.
